chaired by Profs. Felsenberg and Schönau (articles by Burr, Compston, Gasser, Rittweger, Runge, Schiessl and Eckstein)

**'Tendons and Ligaments'**

organized by Prof. Webster SS Jee and co-chaired by Prof. Cyril Frank (articles by Frank, Vogel, Ferretti, Reeves)

Also printed are the abstracts from the 56 posters that were submitted and displayed at the Workshop. A total of 20 out of the 56 submitted papers were chosen for oral presentation in our Poster Session based on scoring of the blinded abstracts by the Scientific Committee.
